# Movement Matters Zone



**Movement Matters** contributes to all the COR Key Experiences particularly improving balance, co-ordination, flexibility, strength of bones and muscles, respiration and cardiovascular rate. Through movement children can:

- Improve locomotion, balance and co-ordination
- Improve flexibility and strength
- Improve eye-hand/eye-foot co-ordination
- Improve large and small motor skill development
- Increase health, body awareness and spatial awareness
- Offer experiences in relaxation and rhythm

# Infant Playground



The key to a baby's physical development is to have plenty of time and space to explore his/her movement potential.

The most important part of movement for young babies is ample time and opportunity to safely and freely explore.

# Toddler Playground

Toddlers will continue develop their:

- Large muscles skills to climb up a hill and down a slide.
- Fine motor skills as they use chalk on the sidewalks.
- Arm and leg muscles depending on whether they throw or kick the balls.





# Preschool Playground



Preschoolers will:

- Strengthen and refine their large muscle skills by engaging in activities like moving through an obstacle course or riding bikes.
- Use shovels and buckets in a purposeful way that supports discovery and creativity as they play in the sand box.



# School Age Playground

School Agers will define their skills when they:

- Use large motor skills climbing up the rope and rock.
- Work on balance while walking on the stepping stones.
- Develop hand/eye coordination as the play Four Square and Basketball.
